
CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
YORK-SEAFORD YOUTH FOOTBALL AND CHEERLEADING LEAGUE,
INC.

The undersigned, pursuant to Chapter 10 of Title 13.1 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, hereby form a non-stock, non-profit organization and to that end set forth the following:

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation is: YORK-SEAFORD YOUTH FOOTBALL AND
CHEERLEADING LEAGUE, INC.

ARTICLE TWO

PURPOSES

It is intended that this corporation shall qualify as a tax exempt corporation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. This corporation is organized to provide the means whereby the youth of YSYFCL may participate in an activity requiring physical and mental competitiveness; to provide a supervised program of proper instruction and adherence to the by-laws of the Peninsula Youth Football Association (PYFA); and to instill in our youth a desire to show good sportsmanship, to be competitive and to participate as a team member to children ages 6-14 years of age. The organization may make distributions to organizations exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, and shall be operated only for the following non-profit and tax exempt purposes and objectives:

To hold and manage funds for charitable uses and purposes, and all other acts allowed by the law.

ARTICLE THREE

MEMBERSHIP

The corporation is to have members based on a per child participation/registration with the organization. Each child represents one vote which may be exercised by a parent or guardian. All other rights and duties of members shall be set forth in the Bylaws of the organization.
